Parents as Partners (PASP)

Our Parents as Partners (PASP) group explores how parents can volunteer and help support both the students and faculty at our schools. Upon admittance to Odyssey, each family commits to a minimum of 18 volunteer hours each school year or 25 hours for two or more students enrolled. Parents also agree to support the schools through our PASP organization. Our students and schools count on your partnership and support!

There are presently two classifications of volunteers:

"A" volunteers who are always under our supervision and "A+" volunteers, who may be assigned students for supervision. "A" volunteers can volunteer at dances, help at athletic games, help to work our concession games, and assist faculty with performances. Only "A+" volunteers are allowed to chaperone students on field trips. All "A+" volunteers must be fingerprinted and background checked by the Brevard County School District. To register as an "A+" volunteer, please visit the Parent Section on our website at <u>www.odysseycharterschool.com</u> and look for Volunteer Opportunities and the link for the application.

There are a variety of ways you can support the schools that will benefit your child from athletics, school dances, plays and musical performances, field trips and field day, and helping with graduation and stepping up ceremonies, as well as the Annual 5K Run. A+ volunteers are sometimes used to monitor hallways during testing season.

All volunteers are required to sign in at the school's front desk on our Raptor system.
